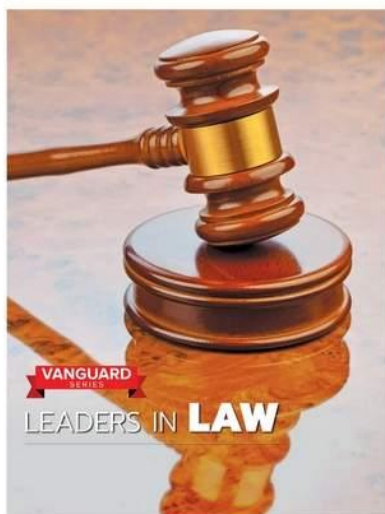


Law**Vanguard Series: Leaders in Law**
