Greenbaum attorney **Joseph A. Natale** will be a panelist for the session “Who's Your Client? Defining Attorney Duties in Non-Clients After Christakos vs. Boyadjis” at the New Jersey State Bar Association’s 2026 Annual Meeting and Convention. The program is scheduled for Thursday, May 14, 2026, from 1:15pm – 2:45pm, at the Borgata Hotel, Casino & Spa in Atlantic City.

The New Jersey Supreme Court recently clarified when a non-client may bring a legal malpractice claim against an attorney in *Christakos v. Boyadjis*. This CLE will examine the current state of the law with two primary areas of focus. First, it will consider attorneys as potential defendants, including the newly adopted Restatement test and when a potential claim must be reported to a malpractice carrier. Second, it will address attorneys representing prospective plaintiffs, highlighting the key facts to evaluate in determining whether a viable claim exists.
